- AndroidManifest.xml → app/src/main/
- Build files → root and app directory

3. Create resource files (strings.xml, colors.xml, styles.xml - see setup_guide.md)

4. Build and run

```
./gradlew build  
./gradlew installDebug
```

▮ UI Components

- **Feed Screen:** Spinnable feed with sorting + search button + infinite scroll
- **Detail Screen:** Full rant text + all comments + back button
- **Search Screen:** Search input + live results
- **Adapters:** Efficient RecyclerView rendering

▮ Technical Highlights

- **No cleartext HTTP:** Uses HTTPS for devrant.com
- **Proper thread safety:** ConcurrentHashMap for cache
- **Memory efficient:** RecyclerView with proper view holders
